McClinton, a graduate of Pennsylvania State University, brings 10 years of experience in sales management and project management. ■

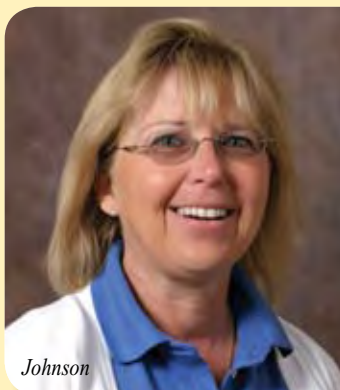
Fraba Announces New General Manager
