## ArmRLite's WZ3D hurricane-resistant door approved by TDI

In June, ArmRLite Overhead Doors announced that the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) approved its WZ3D aluminum and glass hurricane-resistant door for areas outside of high-velocity hurricane zones (HVHZ). The TDI approval means that the WZ3D model complies with the Sectional Garage Door Products: Sectional – Impact Resistant category and ensures that projects using the WZ3D will meet TDI Windstorm inspection program requirements in non-HVHZ areas.

The WZ3D, with its FL46038 approval number, meets all testing criteria specified in the 2018 editions of the International Residential Code (IRC) and International Building Code (IBC) as adopted by TDI on Sept. 1, 2020.
